Support for Communities Affected by 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake

Stanley Electric Co., Ltd. (Head office: 2-9-13 Nakameguro, Meguro-ku, Tokyo; President: Yasuaki Kaizumi) has decided to provide assistance through the provision of our products and donations in response to the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake.

The situation persists where individuals are still struggling to secure water resources in the aftermath of the earthquake. In order to contribute to securing safe and sanitary water, we will donate 33 units of our AlNUV-UV reactors, which sterilize running water with ultraviolet light, to WOTA CORP.

Following the earthquake, WOTA CORP., in cooperation with its affiliated companies, deployed WOTA BOX,* a portable water reuse system that can be used even when the water supply is cut off, to the areas where water outage is continuing, and provided shower kits with access to hot water.

Our AlNUV-UV reactors have been adopted as a unit for sterilizing running water, which is being reused, for the WOTA BOX.

In addition, we will donate 5 million yen to the Central Community Chest of Japan's Ishikawa branch office to support the reconstruction of Ishikawa Prefecture, where the Disaster Relief Act is applied to 10 cities and 7 towns.

Our company and our group companies would like to express our deepest condolences to those who lost their lives due to this earthquake disaster and extend our deepest sympathies to everyone affected. We sincerely hope for the earliest possible recovery of the affected areas.
